From the Board of Trustees

Dear Prospect Sierra Community,

It is hard to believe that we are halfway through the school year! We hope your children are having a wonderful year, and that you have made time, in your own ways, to connect with the PS community.

As board members, we oversee the school's use of financial resources and how they connect to the school's strategy and values. At our monthly meetings, we review the school's financial position including our current year budget versus actual financial performance, the performance of our long-term reserves, and our projected budget for the following school year, which we ultimately approve at the May board meeting every year.

We discuss the school's goals and how the budget relates to those goals and have a healthy dialogue about the need to balance short-term needs and long-term sustainability. It is incredible how much the school can leverage its resources to impact its short-term and long-term goals.

A couple of highlights from the 2022-23 school year include:

- The creation of the Associate Head of Program and Professional Development, and hiring of Abby Guinn.** Under Abby's leadership, we've focused on the following:
 - After surveying the community and researching assessment options, we piloted and deployed MAP Growth assessment in grades 3-8.
 - Vetted by a faculty-led task force, we invested in a new social-emotional curriculum that meets our students where they are today.
 - Abby has expanded the professional development offerings for faculty and staff and has maximized our ability to have many of these opportunities funded by the state.
- Focus on campus security.** A recently awarded grant will allow for new security cameras, campus access controls, and upgrades to fencing and gates. A second grant is pending which may allow for additional security enhancements.
- Outdoor learning spaces.** A process is in place to redesign the Tapscott play yard and improve outdoor learning spaces such as the upper hillside at Avis. Outdoor spaces, whether for play or learning, are a critical component of joyful learning.

We want to continue to invest in our program, keep our faculty and staff compensation competitive, and increase the flexible tuition investments in our community. This is challenging to do at a time when costs such as healthcare and insurance are rising at exponential rates, and we are mindful of the need to keep tuition increases as low as possible. We are fortunate that we are in a position to use some of the operating reserve that has been built up over the last few years and that Nisa and the Senior Admin team are so resourceful and innovative.

As a community, let's continue to support one another and maintain the financial vibrancy of Prospect Sierra. Thank you for your commitment and dedication to this special school community!

2022-23 Development Committee Report

We are privileged to have devoted families, faculty and staff, alumni, alumni parents, grandparents, and friends who generously support Prospect Sierra every year.

As Prospect Sierra’s largest fundraising initiative, the Annual Fund raised over \$385,000 from more than 350 current and alumni families, grandparents, faculty and staff, and friends of the school. This allows Prospect Sierra faculty and staff to bring valuable insights to the classroom through professional development; gives our students innovative learning experiences through academic programs; provides enhancements to our curriculum; supports athletic, art, and drama programming, and also makes possible routine improvements to our campuses, including technology, libraries, colab spaces, and every little thing that sustains our programs and activities.

Our November 2022 Turkey Drive in support of our partnership with The Black Neighborhood raised the funds to purchase 500 turkeys. It brought smiles to families in our neighboring community who may not have had a Thanksgiving dinner without this support.

Count Me In Events, the Spring Walkathon, and Silent Auction - events where fun, friendship, and fundraising come together - raised \$47,000 to support the people and programs that make our school so special.

A generous additional gift from parents Jon Rubenstein and Karin Swann-Rubenstein allowed four additional faculty and staff to attend a week-long Permaculture and Design Certification class over the summer at Occidental Arts & Cultural Center. To date, fourteen faculty and staff have benefitted from this opportunity.

And let’s not forget our amazing volunteers and the Prospect Sierra Parent Association (PSPA) who enrich our community every day. Families play a crucial role in our school community. From driving on field trips, providing hospitality at morning meetings, helping in the classroom and libraries, sewing costumes, serving pizza on Pizza Days, showcasing an Authors & Lectures series, providing support to the Caring Committee when needed, and providing an appreciation lunch to the faculty and staff.

Your belief in the power of education is evident. Love, justice, innovation, and impact are alive and we appreciate every one of you!

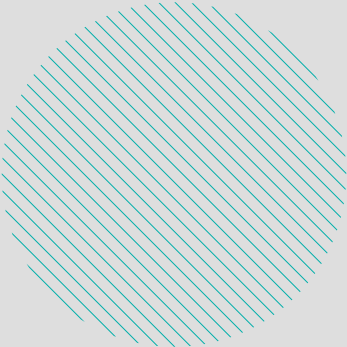

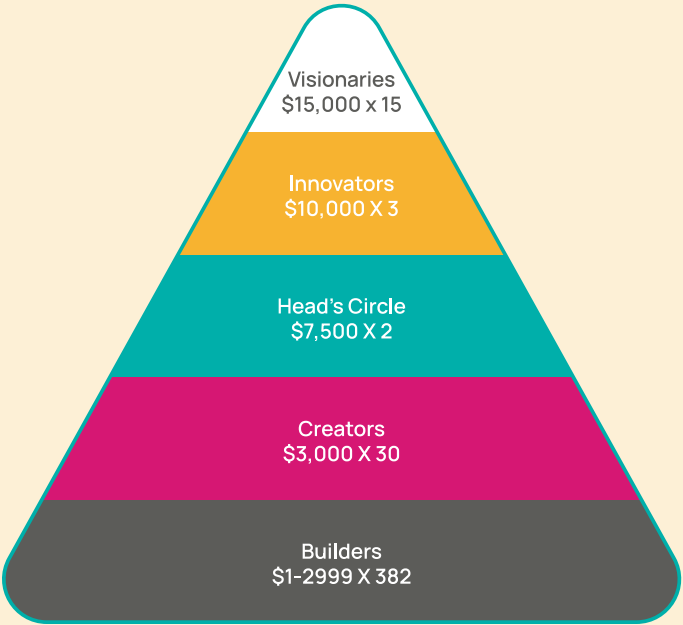


We Are Grateful For You

We are truly grateful for your contributions and for your generosity and participation.

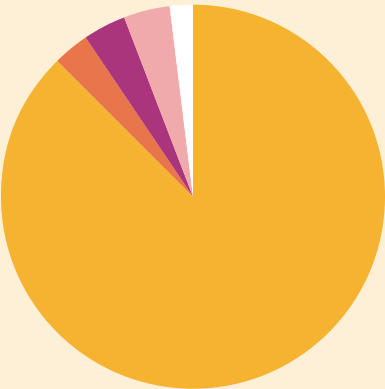


Number of gifts received at every level in 2022-23

Operating budget and financials

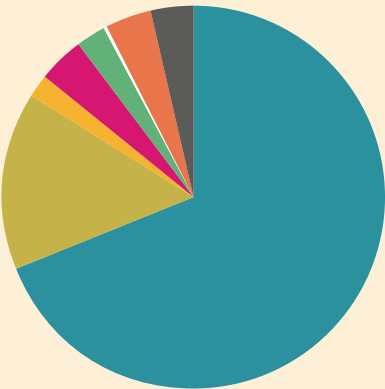

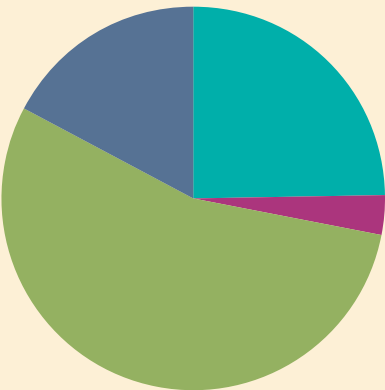
